

Students may either choose to enroll in the MacEwan Bachelor of Science program at Olds College as a **full-time** or as a **part-time** student. The following page outlines how to pursue application and registration for these two options.

### FULL-TIME STUDENTS

1. Fill out an application for Grant MacEwan University at [www.applyalberta.ca](http://www.applyalberta.ca)
2. Choose the "Olds College Campus" during the application process.
3. Your application and admission will be processed by Grant MacEwan University. If you are admitted to the program Olds College will be informed and will be in contact with you regarding specific arrival details. MacEwan will continue to be your contact for course registration, fee payment and student loans.

### PART-TIME STUDENTS

You may also choose to take MacEwan at Olds College courses as a part-time student. You may choose to do so in two ways:

- Apply as a **full-time student** (above). Admitted students can choose to take a full or part-time load.
  - Apply as an **Open Studies student**. [Full details about being an Open Studies student](#) can be found on the MacEwan web site.
1. Fill out an application for Grant MacEwan University at [www.applyalberta.ca](http://www.applyalberta.ca)
  2. Choose the "Open Studies" program during the application process.
  3. Your application and admission will be processed by MacEwan University. If you are admitted to the program Olds College will be informed. After you are admitted, Olds College will be in contact with you regarding specific arrival details. MacEwan will continue to be your contact for course registration, fee payment and student loans.

There are a few other Open Studies details you should be aware of:

1. Learners in Open Studies will be allowed to take a maximum of 30 credits.
2. Admission criteria – There are no admission criteria for Open Studies as it is not considered a program at MacEwan. Students who want to move on to pursue a MacEwan program will need to reapply for studies and be assessed by regular program admission criteria.
3. Prerequisites – Learners are advised that they must meet all pre or co-requisites for individual courses (see page 2).
