-Alpaca Fleece Show drop off at show area between or at Kevin & Leanne Sept's farm.

Classes may be combined or split as required to facilitate judging

Fleeces must have been shorn from the animal during the previous 12 months

Fleece staple length:

-Huacaya over 18 months of age-maximum 6"

-Suri over 18 months of age-maximum 7"

-Any fleece which exceeds the maximum staple length shall be disqualified

Each fleece shall consist of prime fibre only. It shall be skirted, all fibre that does not conform in quality and length to the blanket should be removed. The fleece shall not be washed. The fleece shall be presented in a clear plastic bag complete with a fleece identification form inside.

TYPE, AGE AND COLOR CLASSES (Huacaya & Suri Fleeces)

The following classes will be used on the fleece entry form:

- (H) Huacaya
- (S) Suri
- (1) Juvenile 6-under 14 months
- (2) Intermediate 14-under 24 months
- (3) Senior 24-under 36 months
- (4) Mature 36 months and older

Age category of the alpaca to be determined as of the date shorn in 2012.

- (Wh) **White** Only True Whites
- (Lt) **Light** - includes Beige and Light Fawns
- (Md) **Medium**-includes medium fawn and dark fawn and light browns
- (Dk) **Dark**-includes medium and dark browns
- (Bl) **Black**-includes bay black and black
- (Gr) **Grey**- includes rose grey and silver grey. A predominantly grey alpaca is to be shown in grey, whether or not it has colored spots present.
- (Mu) **Multi**-includes alpacas exhibiting two or more colors over the blanket are (other than greys).

Please be sure to include all three aspects of the code in the order listed; fleece type, age and color. For example, a Dark Fawn Huacaya Alpaca born June 1, 2011 and shorn May 1, 2012 (for fleece show purposed they would be 11 months) the class code would be(HMd1).

AWARDS

In order for a fleece to achieve a first place award in a class, the judge must award a MINIMUM score of 60 points.

If no fleece in a class accumulates the minimum of 60 points, the class shall begin with a second place award.

a. Ribbons will be awarded to third place.

b. Colour champions and reserve colour champions in each colour class for huacaya and suri. First and second place fleeces will compete for colour and reserve colour champions. If no first place is awarded in a class the second place is not eligible for championship.

c. Supreme Huacaya, Supreme Suri - colour champions compete for supreme.

Above placings will be directly related to score awarded.

Only fleeces which have achieved a minimum score of 60 points are eligible to compete for fleece championships.
