

# Master Spinners

## Level Three

*\*indicates an optional item especially for those travelling by air.  
Sharing with others is usually possible for these items.*

### Supplies to be brought by Participant:

#### For the Spinning Room:

- ~ Plastic Baggies (100 sandwich size)
- ~ Scotch tape
- ~ Tags and labels
- ~ Pen and paper
- ~ Spinning wheel oil

#### For the Dye Room:

- ~ 25 – 10 yard skeins of protein fibre yarn. Yarn should be *handspun* for inclusion in the 50-hour project. (have ready for the first day tied loosely and labeled with waterproof ink for dyeing)
- ~ Roll of paper towels
- ~ White adhesive tape or surveyors' flagging tape (orange)
- ~ Waterproof marking pen (Sharpie brand is best. BLACK only.)
- ~ String

### Equipment to be brought by Participant:

#### For the Spinning Room:

- ~ Spinning Wheel
- ~ Lazy Kate
- ~ At least 4 Bobbins
- ~ Niddy Noddy
- ~ Orifice Hook
- ~ \*Spindle bowl
- ~ \*10-12" square frame (outer measurement) with small nails placed at 1" intervals around upper edge
- ~ \*charka or quill wheel (Optional)
- ~ Hand Carders, general all purpose
- ~ Cotton hand carders, if owned
- ~ Support spindle, such as a takli, Russian or Tibetan spindle, or Navajo spindle
- ~ Scissors
- ~ Magnifying glass or linen counter
- ~ Lap cloth
- ~ 12" ruler
- ~ Calculator
- ~ ¼" doweling, approximately 12" long
- ~ WPI gauge or 3 to 4 inch ¼" doweling.

**For the Dye Room:**

- ~ \*Dye pot, 2 – 3 quart capacity, stainless steel, glass or enamel
- ~ Dye thermometer
- ~ Dye Mask
- ~ Measuring spoons
- ~ Measuring cup
- ~ Stir rods
- ~ Rubber gloves
- ~ Clothing cover up or apron
- ~ Oven mitts
