## Level 6

Supplies to be brought by the Participant:

### For the Spinning Room:

- ~ Spinning Wheel with bobbins
- ~ Lazy Kate
- ~ Niddy Noddy
- ~ Hand carders - regular and cotton (if available)
- ~ Labels - large enough to hold pertinent information about skeins
- ~ Baggies
- ~ Flick carder or dog brush
- ~ Combs or mini combs (if available)
- ~ String
- ~ Lap cloth - one dark and one light
- ~ Mesh bag - approximately 18" x 18"
- ~ Silk Reel
- ~ Scissors
- ~ Scotch tape
- ~ Notebook and pen
- ~ Calculator
- ~ Ruler
- ~ Angle gauge
- ~ Wraps per inch gauge
- ~ High whorl spindle, low whorl spindle and support spindle
- ~ Linen counter or magnifying glass
- ~ Scale if available

### For the Dye Room:

- ~ Rubber gloves
- ~ Roll of paper towels
- ~ Clothing cover up
- ~ Plastic skein markers, surveyors' tape or waterproof medical tape
- ~ Waterproof marking pen (to label skeins for dyeing)
- ~ Thermometer
- ~ Stir sticks
- ~ Measuring spoons
- ~ Plastic syringes (assorted sizes)
- ~ 10 - 20 yard skeins, for dyeing with indigo (students choice of fibre - make sure you have an end use for the yarn)

~ 10 - 20 yard skeins of protein fibre (students come prepared, as you will be dying this yarn - you should have a colour scheme and end use for the yarn in mind.)
