Class Organization: All fleeces should be entered in appropriate classes based on age of animal when sheared.

Double fleece coat has fine fibre close to the skin with a coarser outer fibre. A crimp effect to the fibre is sometimes evident.

Single fleece coat (sometimes called "silky") has fine fibre that falls vertically from the body. A loose crimp or wave effect is quite often visible in a single coated fleece.

Suri-Llama fleece coat has defined locks that spiral in rope-like effect. There is little or no crimp.

Awards: Class placement first to fifth place; Grand Champion, Reserve Champion, Best of Show and Spinners' Choice
