

# Master Spinners

## Level Two

Equipment and Supplies to be brought by Participant:

### Spinning:

- ~ Spinning Wheel (rental fee charged, must reserve ahead of time)
- ~ Lazy Kate (rental fee charged, must reserve ahead of time)
- ~ Niddy Noddy
- ~ Bobbins (minimum of 4)
- ~ Drop spindle
- ~ Navajo spindle (only if available)
- ~ Lap cloth (preferably with one dark, and one light, surface)
- ~ Lubricant for spinning wheel

### Fibre Preparation:

- ~ Hand carders, all-purpose. Curved back carders are sometimes easier to use. A tooth density of 48 teeth per square inch works well for fine and medium wools.
- ~ Mini-combs, preferably with table clamp (only if available)
- ~ Flick carder, dog comb or grooming brush
- ~ Small spray bottle to spray fibres on combs
- ~ 1/4" doweling, 12" long for rolling punis
- ~ Dishwashing soap or Orvus paste
- ~ Rubber gloves
- ~ Mesh bag (i.e. hosiery, approx. 18" by 18") for washing fleece
- ~ Salad spinner to remove excess water from fleece (only if available)
- ~ Bath towel to soak up water from fleece and yarn

### Sweater Calculation:

- ~ A sweater or a sweater pattern for calculations
- ~ Cloth measuring tape
- ~ Knitting needles or crochet hooks suitable for handspun yarn (i.e. 3 mm. to 5 mm.)
- ~ Calculator

### General :

- ~ Scissors
- ~ 12" ruler
- ~ Tags or labels for skeins and fibre samples
- ~ Plastic bags for fibre samples (sandwich size)
- ~ Scotch tape
- ~ Cotton or synthetic yarn for tying skeins
- ~ Notebook and pen
