Challenging an Exam

You may challenge the Level I exam if you have a Diploma in Horticulture or have combined experience and education equivalent to a Diploma in Horticulture.

You may challenge the Level II exam if you have Turfgrass Management Level I and a Diploma in Horticulture or if you have a Turfgrass Management Level I and have combined experience and education equivalent to a Diploma in Horticulture.

The fee to challenge the Level I or Level II exam is \$75.00 (+ GST) plus a proctor fee (if applicable).

The Level III exam cannot be challenged.
