1. PERSONAL INFORMATION

International Students

May be required to submit a \$100 CAN Credential Evaluation Fee. This fee will be used to conduct an assessment of your coursework and educational qualifications to compare them to the Alberta admission requirements. The results of this evaluation will be used to assess your eligibility for admission. Applications will not be processed until this fee has been received. This requirement will be waived for students who have completed their education in the United States and United Kingdom or upon the discretion of the Student Recruitment Office.
