

MASTER SPINNERS

Level One Supply & Equipment List

For the Spinning Room

- 1 inch Binder (With front and spine pockets for inserts as a title page and spine are provided – Optional)
- **Spinning Wheel with four bobbins
- Lazy Kate
- Niddy Noddy
- Hand carders (general purpose)
- Top or bottom whorl drop spindle (suggested weight between 20 and 35 grams)
- Flick carder or dog comb
- Notebook and pen
- Scissors
- Lap cloth or apron (optional)
- Tags or labels to identify skeins
- Ziplock-type bags (25 sandwich size and 20 large size)

(Cotton yarn, scotch and masking tape, permanent marker, dishwashing soap, mesh for washing fleece, and paper towels will be supplied).

For the Dye Room

- Approximately 150 yards of white 100% wool yarn (handspun or commercial). Yarn will be prepared for dyeing in class.
- Dust mask
- Rubber gloves
- Clothing cover-up
- Oven mitts

(Dye pots, dye thermometers, stir sticks (chopsticks work well), labeling tape, measuring spoons will be supplied).

For off campus students, please bring your own 1-2 gallon stainless steel dye pot and a dye thermometer. (Do not bring if traveling by air. These two items can be shared with other participants).

** For all offerings of the Master Spinner program (both on and off the Olds College campus), manually operated spinning wheels are mandatory in the classroom, unless the student has been given prior permission to use an electronic spinner by the Program Manager.
