Level Two Supply & Equipment List

For the Spinning room (String, scotch and masking tape, permanent marker, dishwashing soap, mesh for washing fleeces, and paper towels will be supplied).

- 1 inch Binder (With front and spine pockets for inserts as a title page and spine are provided - Optional)
- **Spinning Wheel with four bobbins
- Lazy Kate
- Niddy Noddy
- Hand carders (general purpose)
- Top or bottom whorl drop spindle (suggested weight between 20 and 35 grams)
- Flick carder or dog comb
- Mini-combs (if available)
- Navajo spindle (if available)
- Notebook and pen
- Calculator
- Scissors
- Lap cloth or apron (optional)
- Tags or labels to identify skeins
- Ziplock-type bags (sandwich size)
- Tape measure or ruler
- Rubber gloves if needed for washing fleece
- A sweater you might like to copy OR a pattern with measurements (for a calculations exercise)
- Knitting needles or crochet hooks appropriate for the sweater yarn you intend to make.

No dyeing supplies are required for Level Two.

** For all offerings of the Master Spinner program (both on and off the Olds College campus), manually operated spinning wheels are mandatory in the classroom, unless the student has been given prior permission to use an electronic spinner by the Program Manager.
