

# Master Spinner Level 3 Student Supply List

## For the Classroom

Spinning Wheel with at least four bobbins  
Maintenance items for spinning wheel (oil, replacement drive band, etc.)  
Orifice Hook  
Lazy Kate  
Niddy Noddy  
Hand carders (general purpose)  
Cotton hand carders (if owned)  
Support spindle, such as a takli, Russian or Tibetan spindle  
Spindle Bowl  
Scissors  
Magnifying glass or linen counter  
Lap cloth  
12" ruler  
Calculator  
1/4" doweling, approximately 12" long  
WPI gauge or 3 to 4 inch 1/4" doweling  
Ziplock-type bags ( 100 sandwich size)  
Tags/labels  
Pen and Paper

**Off Campus Students:** 1 inch Binder for module (with front and spine pockets for inserts as a title page and spine are provided)

### Optional Supplies:

8 to 12" square frame (outer measurement) with a small nail placed at each corner  
(for making silk mawata)  
Charkha or quill wheel (optional)

## For the Dye Room

25 - 10 yard skeins of protein fibre yarn. Yarn should be handspun for inclusion in the 50-hour project. (Have ready for first day - tied loosely with 4 figure-eight ties per skein)  
Clothing cover up or apron  
Rubber gloves  
Dust mask

Dye thermometer

Dye Pot 1- 2 gallon capacity stainless steel, glass or enamel
