

# Master Spinner Level 5 Student Supply List

## For the Classroom

Spinning Wheel with at least four bobbins  
Maintenance items for spinning wheel (oil, replacement drive band, etc.)  
Lazy Kate  
Niddy Noddy  
Hand carders (general purpose)  
Cotton Carders (if available)  
Linen counter  
Calculator  
Scissors  
Lap cloth or apron  
Tags or labels to identify skeins (should be water and heat proof)  
Ziplock-type bags (sandwich size)  
Notebook and Pen  
Textbook for information or material to be used by you in classroom presentation to peers.  
(Topic for presentation is your choice as long as it pertains to spinning and is for a lower level of spinners approx 15 minutes long)

**Off Campus Students:** 1 inch Binder for module (with front and spine pockets for inserts as a title page and spine are provided)

## Dye Room

Skeins for dyeing:  
(Do not use corn fibre as it does not dye with this kind of dye)  
    Colour wheel: 12 skeins, 16 yards each of handspun cotton or linen  
    8 skeins, 20 yards each of handspun cellulose fibre to dyeing in class  
    (to be used for a project plus a small skein to accompany project for marking)  
    Injection dyeing: 4 skeins, 10 yards each of handspun cellulose fibre  
Clothing cover up or apron  
Rubber gloves  
Dust mask  
Large thick zipoc plastic bags for dying of skeins (min 12)

## Optional Supplies:

(These supplies will be provided in limited numbers by Host/Instructor, but bringing your own for yourself or to share will assist in classroom activities)

Oven mitts  
Dye thermometer  
Dye Pot 1- 2 gallon capacity stainless steel  
Stir sticks (chop sticks work well)
