Olds College Award Selection Philosophy

The Olds College Awards Selection Philosophy is to make awards available to the greatest number of learners within the requirements and conditions of the award.

Awards are granted at the discretion of the designated selection committees. All decisions made by selection committees are final and may not be appealed.

General Information

Selection of Award Recipients

All scholarships, bursaries and awards recipients are chosen by an Awards Selection Committee including the Awards Administrator and/or Instructional Teams. Decisions are based on the “type” of award and the eligibility requirements as outlined in this booklet.

Types of Awards

Scholarships:

Scholarships are selected primarily on the basis of academic proficiency, which is assessed according to the student's cumulative GPA.

Bursaries:

Bursaries are selected primarily on the basis of financial need.

Prize/Award:

An award given in recognition of some specific outstanding accomplishment or contribution. Prizes may be in the form of gifts, plaques, subscriptions or money.

Definitions

Eligibility:

The requirements that qualify a student to be chosen as a recipient.

Criteria:

The standards on which a judgment or decision may be based.

Award Eligibility

- Students must be enrolled FULL-TIME.
- Students must maintain a minimum cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA) of 2.00 (unless otherwise stated).
- Students on academic probation will not be considered. This does not include those students who have been placed on probation due to college admission as a “Special Student”.
- A student who receives an award, scholarship, or bursary, and whose academic standing then changes to probation in a subsequent term will not lose the award. However, they will be ineligible for any future monies until they are removed from probation.
- Academic Upgrading students are not eligible for Olds College scholarships.
- Students who are sponsored, or are receiving Skills Development Grants, and/or Labour Market Development funding are not eligible for Olds College Bursaries.
- Students must meet the specific eligibility requirements as outlined for each award.

For the purpose of awards administered by Olds College, a **resident of Alberta is defined as** (unless otherwise stated):

A single person who has been out of high school for less than four years, and

- whose parents live in Alberta; or
- whose parents have recently left and the student has stayed in Alberta to study; or
- has spent two periods of 12 consecutive months available to the labour force and Alberta is the last province in which 12 consecutive months have been spent, excluding time spent at a post-secondary institution.

A person who has been out of high school for four years or more, or

- is married/has been married; or
- is living common-law; or
- is a single parent
- and Alberta is the last province in which 12 consecutive months have been spent, excluding time spent at a post-secondary institution.

A person studying in Alberta and married to an Alberta resident.

Application for Awards

You will find applications for awards “**on-line**” in any student computer lab on campus. Just look for the “Awards” icon on the screen. **When applying for awards you will need your Social Insurance and Student ID numbers**

Timelines for Applying

Fall Scholarships and Bursaries

August 15th to October 14th, 2013

Winter Scholarships and Bursaries

October 15th – December 31st, 2013

If you have applied for Fall Awards your application is automatically carried over for Winter Awards. This means that you only have to apply once for both Fall and Winter Awards. However, if you apply after October 15th your application is only accepted for Winter Awards.

Applying for Bursaries

- Refer to your Notice of Assessment from the Students Finance for Government Student Loan figures. Include all funding for the entire academic year.
- If you have a student line of credit from a bank, include the entire amount you have been approved for the entire academic year.
- Information that is found to be inaccurate or incomplete will make your application null and void.
- Applications are subject to audit, inaccurate information will render you ineligible for awards for the entire academic year.

Payment of Awards

- Most awards that are administered by Olds College are not received until the student has contacted the Student Awards Administrator and sent a thank you note to the donor of their award.
- Award winners must be enrolled as a full-time Olds College student and in good standing on the day that the money is released, in order to be eligible to receive the funds.
- Student cheques will be released to students only if the student's college account is paid in full.
- If a student is granted an award, Olds College reserves the right to release pertinent information to the donor of the award and provincial funding bodies.

NOTE:

- Olds College assumes liability for the payment of scholarships, bursaries and prizes only to the extent that expected gifts from donors or returns from particular investments of endowed funds are realized.
- Olds College reserves the right to give awards to any student, students who have not applied for awards may not claim any right of consideration by the College.
- Not every award is necessarily granted each year.

Criteria: Academic excellence; (students are ineligible if they are receiving more than \$3,500 in other awards for the current academic year).
