Objective:	The purpose of this policy is to set a common grading system to ensure that students are consistently assessed and graded equitably.
Policy:	The students' level of achievement in each gradable course will be recorded and reported on the transcript.
	 Grading System Credit courses will utilize a letter grading system as defined on the grade conversion chart in the Procedures. In cases where it is appropriate, a course may have a pass/fail (P/F) grading system in place of the standard letter grading system. Normally this will only occur where the nature of the outcomes being evaluated or the subject matter makes it necessary in order to guarantee fairness. Non-credit courses may be non-gradable, utilize a letter grade, percentage or pass/fail grading system
