## For the Classroom

Spinning Wheel with extra bobbins  
Lazy Kate  
Niddy Noddy  
Hand carders – regular and cotton (if available)  
Flick carder or dog brush  
Wool combs or mini combs (if available)  
Labels – large enough to hold pertinent information about skeins  
Plastic bags (sandwich size)  
Mesh bag – approximately 18" X 18"  
Scissors  
Notebook and pen  
Calculator and Ruler  
Angle gauge and Wraps per inch gauge  
High whorl Spindle, Low whorl Spindle, and Support Spindle  
Linen counter or magnifying glass  
Scale (if available)

**Off Campus Students:** 1 inch Binder for module (with front and spine pockets for inserts as a title page and spine are provided)

(cotton yarn, scotch and masking tape, permanent marker will be supplied in a class room box)

## For the Dye Room

(stir sticks, adhesive tape, dye thermometer, measuring spoons etc. will be supplied)

Dust mask, Rubber gloves, and Clothing cover up  
10-12 large thick zip-loc plastic bags for dyeing skeins  
Skeins for dyeing:

10 skeins, 20 yards each, for dyeing with indigo

(student's choice of fibre – make sure you have an end use for the yarn)

10 skeins, 20 yards each of protein fibre (You will be dyeing this yarn so you should come prepared with a colour scheme and end use for the yarn in mind)
