Equine Care & Management Certificate

1	<p>Equine Diseases: Prevention and First Aid Care</p> <p>Students will learn about common diseases and conditions horses acquire. Discussion on how to prevent disease, how to provide first aid care, and when to contact medical professionals will be emphasized.</p>
2	<p>Life Stages of the Horse</p> <p>Students will learn about the life stages of the horse and the physical needs at each stage. Keeping the horse in its best health at each stage will be emphasized, with a focus on communicating care decisions, and recognizing the business implications of equine care and management practices.</p>
3	<p>Equine Industry Field Placement</p> <p>Students will create a learning plan for their field study and instructors will provide guidance to finding an appropriate field study location.</p> <p>Note: Students will complete a 6-8 week (minimum 200 hour) industry placement during the summer, as a requirement for this course.</p>
