3. NEW BUSINESS - POLICY REVIEW

- **3.1.** D31 Academic Integrity Policy (M.Medinsky)
 - Recognized the need for modernization of this policy. Spirit of the policy has not changed, but the provides more clarity around who is responsible for how decisions are made
 - Addition of the Complaints and Appeals procedure
 - Committee was in favour of a formative process when it comes to students and faculty being educated about academic integrity. There are clearly articulated steps on how to proceed. However, this is not a punitive policy.

• It was noted that there is no threshold for an academic integrity penalty or appeal of a student.

- Discussion that contract cheating does not need to be specifically identified as the spirit of contract cheating is well covered in the policy and procedure.
- Amendment to procedure: It was noted that the Student Action Plan and it's related information, is out of date in the procedure. Clarified that this will need to be edited prior to the CLT meeting.

- 3.2. D30 Complaints and Appeals (2019) (P.Mal)
 - 3.2.1. <u>Student Disputes, Complaints and Appeals Procedure</u>
 - CAQC identified the need for the clarity for a procedure that was related to the code of conduct
 - Proposing to remove it from the policy framework
 - This procedure is meant to address student disputes, complaints and appeals
 - It was determined that the 15% would remain in the procedure for re-evaluation purpose
 - Amendment to procedure: change the words '*exam*' and '*assignment*' to '*assessment*' throughout the document
 - Amendment to procedure, Academic Dispute Process for Marked Assignments, Bullet #1: Replace the word 'a' with 'any'
 - Correction to procedure, Appealing of Decisions and Outcomes Resulting in Expulsion, Bullet #6: the word 'peasant' to 'present'
 - Amendment to procedure, Appeals to the Vice President responsible for Academics, #2: replace *'the appeal will be handled by'* with *'the VPA will declare a conflict of interest to the President who will appoint an alternate Vice President to hear the appeal'*.

3.3. <u>D32 Academic Standing Policy</u> (D.MacDonald)

- Last revised in 2016 and was recommended for revision by CAQC. The new format has policy and procedure separated
- Consultations have occurred with Associate Deans, OCFA and SAOC
- Included recognition of a President and Dean's list as a means of honoring academic achievement
- Apprenticeship students do not receive transcripts the same way as credit students do. Developed a mechanism within the procedure that allowed us to recognize apprenticeship students
- Honour and Distinction does not apply to this policy. The Grading policy and Graduation policy still include these terms.
- It was noted that links in Policy D19 Grading are no longer working
- Amendment to procedure: Include the number/letter code
- Amendment to procedure: Add 'applied degrees' as well as 'degrees'

 - In 2016, the Equine Science Diploma program underwent a Comprehensive Program Review.
 In 2018, all specializations were suspended in favor of a single-stream program. In March 2020, Olds College Academic Council was made aware of the intent to suspend intake in the Equine Science Diploma due to institutional capacity, low student completion and satisfaction rates, and a need for a program redevelopment (exploration of Certificate-level credentials).
 - Proposal will be submitted to the Ministry to suspend the credential of equine science. All students who have started the program have a plan to allow them to complete their credential. Once these students have completed their credential, a motion will be made to terminate this program
 - Amendment: adjust language to reflect the impacts on faculty and staff

4.2. Werklund School of Agriculture Technology

- 4.2.1. <u>Revised Course Outline AMT 2020 Advanced Product Marketing</u> (J.Benkie)
 - The updates to this course reflect current topics in agriculture and agri-food marketing. Updates also aim to include a more diverse scope of agriculture products (and service) market offerings. Furthermore, competencies relating to market research and related processes has been factored in as it relates to agribusiness decision-making.

• The course description was revised to better highlight the specific areas of livestock production that would be covered in LVS 1370, specifically to reflect the newly revised General Areas of Competencies and Competency Statements. The course description was also revised to emphasize that LVS 1370 will provide hands-on exposure to livestock animals, which we felt was a crucial learning opportunity for first year students in the Agriculture Management program.

• It was determined the recommendation of taking LVS 2370 and LVS 2470 prior to LVS 2070 was not necessary as students can be very successful within this course without taking these classes. Revision of the course overview included a removal of the feeding regime as that is the Olds College Farm role and added hands-on labs to better align with what takes place in this course
