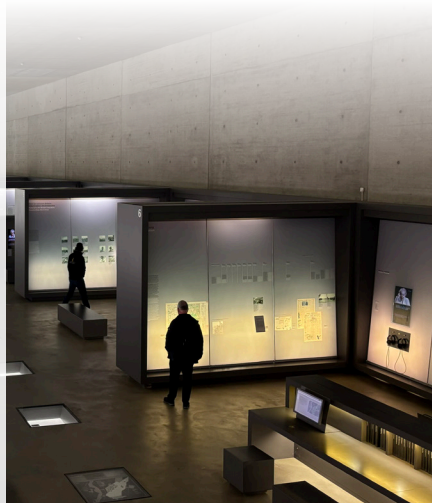

Bergen-Belsen is a solemn historical site that began as a POW camp and later became a Nazi concentration camp, where tens of thousands, including Anne Frank, tragically lost their lives, offering a powerful and educational reflection on the Holocaust.
