4.1. School of Life Science & Business

4.1.1. <u>VETMEDR, VETMEDO - Veterinary Medical Receptionist</u> (A.Ngai)

 In order to provide the Veterinary Medical Receptionist (VMR) students with their required work-integrated learning (WIL) opportunity, the PCC is adding a course to Term 2, which incorporates WIL on campus. It also has students conducting career-related research and development of a portfolio, so they are ready for work placement and entry level employment.

Motion AC080525.4 by A.Ngai to approve the load change to VETMEDR, VETMEDO - Veterinary Medical Receptionist and move to the Board of Governors for approval as presented CARRIED

4.1.2. New Course - ANH 1590 - Applied Industry Skills (A.Ngai)

- This course serves to provide VMR with a WIL opportunity within the second term of their program of study. WIL components to be offered within the AHEC Hospital include storefront activities, daily care of animals and observations of clinical procedures in the hospital.
- Career related and portfolio development will also occur that will assist students in successfully finding a place of employment.
- Friendly Amendment: Add language to the Calendar Description such as "Students will be responsible for caring for small animals outside class time" to help students be more aware that there is an outside of classroom commitment.

4.1.3. EQN 1390 - Equine Massage Field Placement (A.Ngai)

- This course is moving out of Term 3 and into Term 2 of the program.
- This proposal adjusts courses being taught at the same time in Term 2 as co-requisites, while ensuring students have the necessary knowledge and skills from Term 1 (pre-requisites) to be successful in this course.
- There was a recommendation to amend the Calendar Description language from "final practical exam" to "final practical assessment". Action Item: A.Nagai will bring this back to the PCC for discussion. This is an FIO item.

Motion AC080525.6 by A.Ngai to approve the pre and/or co requisites for EQN 1390 - Equine Massage Field Placement as presented CARRIED

- Proposed change to move the Equine 1390 course out of Term 3 and into Term 2 to allow students to complete the program by end of Term 2.
- Students can then complete the certificate program in eight months, which removes
 the requirement of students having to return to campus at the end of June for the final
 practical exam of Equine 1390.

4.2. School of Trades & Skills

- **4.2.1.** AGHEQUD Agricultural and Heavy Equipment (D.Beaudoin)
 - The students in the Agriculture & Heavy Equipment diploma have an unbalanced workload. Students take five courses in Term 1 (fall) and five courses in Term 2 (winter). Term 2 includes three core courses and two major-specific courses. The difference between Term 1 and Term 2 is in the total hours allocated to these courses. Currently, students in the fall term have 315 hours and in the winter term have 395 hours for the AG Major.
 - Moving the COMMS 1020 class from the winter term to the fall term will allow for a more balanced student workload: 360 in Term 1 and 340 in Term 2.
