Objective:	To ensure the College is in compliance with all federal, provincial and municipal laws concerning the provision, production and consumption of alcohol on our campus. The College recognizes that individuals 18 years of age and older have the right to consume alcohol at the locations designated in this policy and related procedure, providing that it is consumed in a safe and responsible manner and in conjunction with current legislation.
Policy:	This policy and related procedure outlines the College's expectations for the provision and consumption of alcohol on the College campus, and at College events by students, employees, and guests.
	There is a corresponding responsibility to do so without risking harm to themselves, others, or public and private property, and to not adversely impact learning activities, living environments and the business operations of Olds College.
Definitions:	ProServe : Is Alberta's responsible liquor service and sales program. It's designed to help ensure that liquor is sold and served according to law and AGLC policies, and in a way that keeps customers, guests and others safe from alcohol-related harms.
	AGLC : The Alberta Gaming and Liquor Commission (AGLC) oversees the province of Alberta's liquor industry, offering Albertans unparalleled selection, convenience, and responsible customer service.
