Objective:	The purpose of this policy is to demonstrate compliance with the Government of Alberta's Fairness and Safety in Sport Act (the "Act") and Fairness and Safety in Sport Regulation (the "Regulation").
Policy:	For Olds College of Agriculture & Technology (the "College") sanctioned athletic participation, the following eligibility criteria will apply in compliance with the Act and Regulation.
	Athlete Eligibility To participate in a female-only league, class or division of a relevant sport, an athlete must be of the female sex at birth.
	For athlete participation in provincial sport organizations, Olds College will adopt the provincial sport organizations eligibility requirements and processes to comply with the Act.
Definitions:	Athlete: A participant registered in a relevant sport.
	Relevant Sport: An amateur competitive sport or sport discipline governed, regulated, coordinated, promoted or sponsored by Olds College.
