

TUITION WAIVER - INTERNATIONAL STUDENT ATHLETICS PROGRAM

Overview:	<p>Olds College of Agriculture & Technology (the "College") values the contribution of international student-athletes and coaches to campus life, athletic competition and the quality of the educational experience at the College. This procedure outlines the eligibility criteria for international student-athletes at the College that wouldn't otherwise be here.</p>
Procedures:	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The tuition waiver applies to a student who is nominated by their head coach, is registered as a full-time student at the College and is a member of a designated ACAC varsity team or varsity rodeo team. If the student ceases to be a full-time student, is removed from the team, or does not maintain their academic standing, the student will be required to pay full international tuition. 2. Value of the partial tuition waiver is equivalent to the difference between the domestic and international tuition allowing the international student to pay the same tuition as a Canadian resident would pay for the same program. 3. The usual revenue split for tuition from international students is such that the academic program receives the amount equivalent to what a domestic student pays for tuition and the remainder is allocated to the International Department. Under this policy, the International Department forgoes its portion of the revenue split for these international students. 4. Recipients will be selected based on the following criteria: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. They must be an international student who otherwise would be required to pay full international tuition to attend the College. b. They must be enrolled as a full-time student at the College (eg. taking 3 academic courses (or equivalent to 9 credits) per term. They must maintain a minimum average of 60% or a 1.7 GPA in their previous term to retain their International Tuition Waiver. 5. These terms must be included on the athlete's Letter of Intent (LOI) signed by the coach, the prospective student-athlete, and the Manager, Athletics. 6. At the discretion of the Manager, Athletics one (1) waiver per year may be allocated to an international student who will have responsibilities in a coaching capacity with Broncos Athletics.

Definitions:

Student-athlete: Refers to a student who is recognized as a full time student at the College and an active member of an ACAC or CCRA varsity sport at the College.

Letter of Intent (LOI): Official letter issued by Broncos Athletics Department declaring intention of prospective student-athletes commitment to attend the College and compete in their respective sport for the Olds College Broncos
